The area was named after the captain Barbati, when he led a group of Peloponnesian refugees from Nafplio and Monemvasia to the northeast coast of Corfu in 1571. Barbati was a small village of fishermen and farmers. The village grew in importance during the Venetian rule of Corfu (13th-18th centuries).

Afionas

A traditional village with a rich history and stunning sunsets

Nestled in a mountainous headland on the west coast of Corfu, Afionas is a hidden gem that offers stunning views, rich history, and a charming traditional atmosphere. The village is located about 37 kilometers from Corfu Town and has panoramic views of the Ionian Sea, the islet of Gravia, the Diapontia Islands (Mathraki and Othonoi), and the Gulf of Agios Georgios.

A walk through the village's winding stone paths (kadounia) reveals a wealth of architectural treasures, including traditional stone houses, elegant mansions, and the 17th-century church of Agios Ioannis Lampataria.

About a 20-minute walk to the southwest, you'll find the stunning double beach of Porto Timoni. This two-part beach is separated by a narrow strip of land and has been named one of the best beaches in Europe.

Afionas is one of the oldest settlements on Corfu and is believed to have been named after the local grape variety. Archaeological evidence suggests that the village was first inhabited in the 6th century BC.

In addition to its long history and traditional character, Afionas is also known for its stunning natural beauty. The sunsets from the village are particularly breathtaking, with fiery colors that transform the atmosphere into a spectacle that is sure to leave you breathless.
